

Current activities include: Continue sanitary sewer and waterline project wide. Continuing track construction. Working on temporary traffic signal at FM 1830/US 377 intersection. Milling old northbound lane and shoulder and grading embankment for cement treatment. Form and pour remaining inlets on storm sewer system B.

Narrative description of last month's activities: Continued installing City of Denton utilities project wide. Shifted northbound traffic to new concrete pavement north of UPRR bridge. Shifted northbound and southbound traffic to detour pavement south of bridge to south of Daniels Street. Set girders and poured approach slabs on shoofly bridge. Completed subballast installation.


Narrative description of activities planned for next month: Continue with installation of City of Denton utilities project wide. Complete remaining inlets on storm sewer system B. Form and pour sidewalks on east side of US 377, north of bridge. Pave asphalt and concrete pavement for northbound left-turn lane. Switch southbound traffic to new concrete paving mid-October.

Traffic issues: Traffic switch occurred on September 21 to move northbound traffic to the new concrete pavement north of bridge. Northbound and southbound traffic switched to detour pavement south of bridge to south of Daniels Street. Traffic switch to move southbound traffic to new concrete pavement in mid-October.

Other items of significance: Time impact analysis currently under review for potential delays to project on sanitary sewer line through trailer park.








- Schematic: Schematic approval received on January 31, 2019.

Anticipate environmental clearance after project has been brought into conformity through an out-of-cycle STIP revision.
- **ROW:** Parcel count is 216 in Denton County and 21 in Cooke County.

- **Funding:** This project received \$546,512,296 in CAT 12 funding. Funding was approved by the Texas Transportation Commission on August 29, 2019.



- **Schematic:** Jacobs made the 60% schematic submittal for the frontage roads project on January 16, 2019. HNTB received the files from Jacobs and began updating the main lane schematic.
- HNTB submitted the 60% schematic for main lanes project on April 12, 2019, for use at the VE study.
- VE study for frontage road and main lanes project was held April 22-25, 2019. TxDOT continues review of VE report. Report pending District approval.
- Both frontage road and main lane projects are coordinating design to accelerate the frontage road project.
- Main lane project is on hold until frontage road project receives schematic approval.
- Traffic received from TP&P on August 27, 2019.




- PS&E, CSJ: 0135-10-057 (Loop 288 to US 377): TxDOT design team completed work on 95% plans and submitted for review on May 20, 2019.
- PS&E, CSJ: 0135-10-050 (US 377 to County Line): Consultant completed work on 95% plans and submitted for review on July 26, 2019.
- ROW: For CSJ: 0135-10-057, there are 26 parcels for acquisition; 13 have been acquired; 2 are in negotiations; 11 are in ED. For CSJ: 0135-10-050, there are 104 parcels for acquisition; 50 have been acquired; 8 are in negotiations; and 46 are in ED.
- Utilities: Utility coordination meeting held on September 19, 2019. Utilities in conflict are: AT&T, Atmos, City of Denton, City of Frisco, CoServ Electric, CoServ Gas, Charter/Spectrum, DME, DISD, Frontier, Grande, MCI/Verizon, Mustang SUD, Nortex, Oncor, Suddenlink, UTRWD, and Zayo. City staff to review utility relocations required for project.
- Funding: For CSJ -050: \$47.1M in Proposition 1 funds; \$14M in STP-MM funds. For CSJ -057: \$13M in Proposition 1 funds. US 380 has been listed as a project on the 10-year plan with an additional \$28.6M. City council approved a LPAFA on September 12, 2017, for the 10-foot sidewalk component from Mayhill to the Greenbelt in the amount of \$848,874.75.



Current Status:

- Environmental: Public meeting was held on March 28, 2019. CP&Y continues work on environmental documents. Anticipate public hearing in January 2020.
- **Schematic:** Schematics revised to match MTP. Public meeting and 90% submittal and later show both frontage roads with the ultimate Loop 288 main lanes ghosted.
- Traffic received on August 27, 2019. CP&Y incorporated traffic into 90% schematic and submit for review. Due to issues noted in traffic received, CP&Y is coordinating with TxDOT regarding updated traffic. Submittal of 90% schematic will be made upon resolution of traffic.
- Anticipate submittal of 100% schematic in December 2019.
- CP&Y and TxDOT to coordinate regarding revised project schedule now that traffic has been received.
- **Construction:** The northbound frontage road will be constructed first.


- Schematic: LTRA made 60% submittal to TxDOT on December 21, 2018. TxDOT completed review of schematic and provided 60% plan comments to LTRA.
- Meeting with City of Denton, TxDOT, LTRA, and ITS was held on May 14, 2019, to discuss round-a-bout at Western and addressing Bonnie Brae connectivity. Round-a-bout alternative requested by City of Denton was incorporated at the intersection of FM 1515 and Western. The round-a-bout alternative was included in the schematic rollplots displayed at the public meeting.
- Traffic projection memo resubmitted to TxDOT addressing preliminary comments. Awaiting final approval of traffic projections.
- Environmental: LTRA submitted the Scope Development Tool to TxDOT for review. LTRA coordinated the environmental document type for the project: Categorical Exclusion.
- Public meeting was held on August 29, 2019, at the Embassy Suites Hilton Denton Convention Center. There were approximately 30 attendees with no objections to the project received in verbal comments. Written comment period ended on September 13, 2019. Work is progressing on multiple environmental technical reports to progress the environmental document. Five technical reports have been submitted to TxDOT for review.


- Schematic: Garver has submitted final concept schematic for approval. Concept schematic to be sent to Design Division for final review after several modifications are made.
