

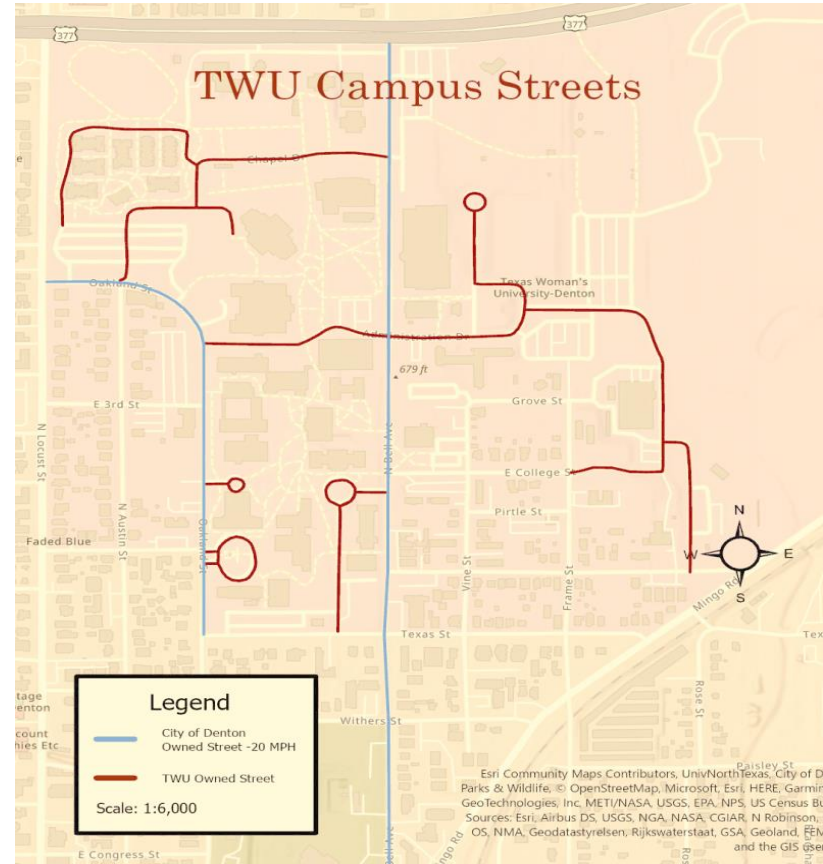
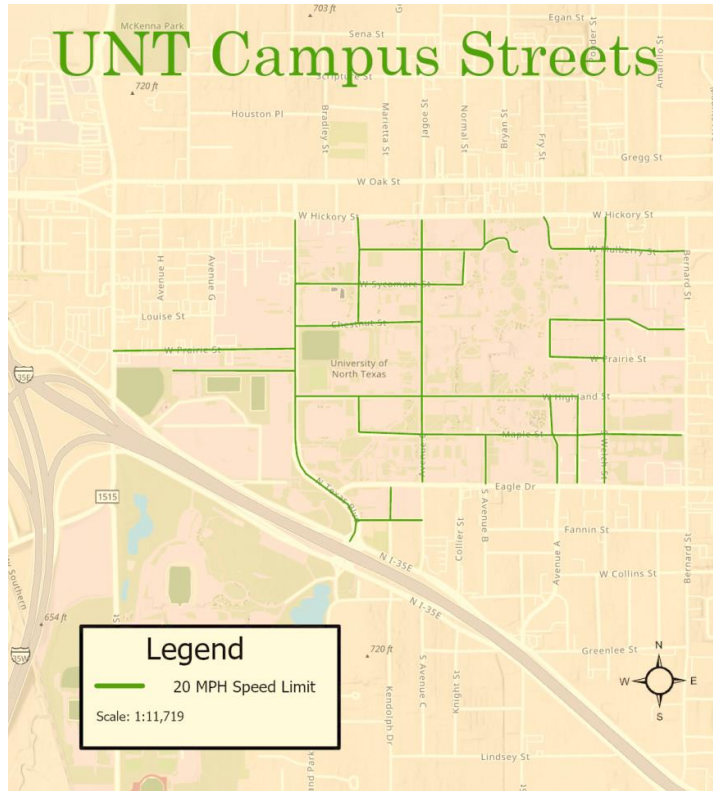
Golf Carts or Off Highway Vehicles for University Use

Background and Purpose

- December 2022 - City Council adopted Ordinance 22-1901 which revised speed limits to classify all streets within the campus as University Campus Streets and designated a 20 mph speed limit.
- Allow for the University of North Texas and Texas Woman's University to operate a Golf Cart or Off Highway Vehicle for:
 - Official University of North Texas or Texas Woman's University business only and
 - Within the University of North Texas and Texas Woman's University campus only (as defined on map)



Golf Cart and Off Highway Vehicles

- Definition of where to be used
 - Publicly owned “Highway” = road, street, way, thoroughfare or bridge in the City
 - Highways or University Campus Streets as defined per Ordinance 22-1901 running through and adjacent to campus with posted speed limits of not more than 20 mph within the University of North Texas and Texas Woman’s University
- Requirement of the Equipment:
 - Must be equipped with headlamps, taillamps, reflectors, parking brake, mirrors and any other items required under the Texas Transportation Code
 - University logo on the vehicle
- Requirement of the Operator:
 - Must be age of 18
 - Hold a Valid Driver’s License
 - Must have valid University Identification

Golf Cart and Off Highway Vehicles Next Steps

Staff recommends adoption of an Ordinance approving the Golf Cart and Off Highway Vehicle use for the University of North Texas and Texas Woman's University as prescribed.
