### SUBJECT

Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding a future fire station in the southwestern portion of the city.

### BACKGROUND

The Fire Department continues to see an increase in overall call for service volume, specifically in the southwest portion of the city. Data and response trends allow staff to conservatively predict the work load of future years. Staff ran a response analysis and compared call response times based on National Fire Protection Association Standard 1710, Standard for the Organization and Deployment of Fire Suppression Operations, Emergency Medical Operations, and Special Operations to the Public by Career Fire Departments.

The City and Denton County Emergency Services District #1 entered an interlocal agreement (ILA) in 2018 to provide fire and EMS services to the Robson Ranch community. The City funds a portion of annual operations costs for the fire station, apparatus, and personnel to provide initial response to Robson Ranch. With the ILA set to expire in September 2028, the City is actively preparing to assume full responsibility for this area.

A proposed Fire Station 10/Hunter Ranch, when constructed, will reduce extended response times south of Interstate 35W, including Robson Ranch, Country Lakes, and the Hunter Ranch area.
