

CITY OF DENTON CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

July 22, 2025

After determining that a quorum was present, the City Council of the City of Denton, Texas convened in a Work Session on Tuesday, July 22, 2025, at 2:01 p.m. in the Council Work Session Room at City Hall, 215 E. McKinney Street, Denton, Texas.

PRESENT: Mayor Gerard Hudspeth, Mayor Pro Tem Suzi Rumohr and Council Members Brian Beck, Vicki Byrd, Joe Holland and Jill Jester. Council Member Brandon Chase McGee arrived at 2:52 p.m.

ABSENT: None

Also present were City Manager Sara Hensley and City Attorney Mack Reinwand.

The posted agenda noted the registration process for in-person and public participation at this meeting. While citizen commentary received via the online registration process was not read, each member for the City Council received each online commentary as it was submitted. 3. Work Session Reports

- A. ID 24-2617 Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding the Fiscal Year 2025-26 preliminary Capital Improvement Program. [Estimated Presentation/ Discussion time: 60 minutes]

The item was presented, and discussion followed.

Council requested:

- staff to provide a breakdown of the projects that are recommended to be delayed, and the cost implication of the delays; and
- staff to follow up on numbers and growth percentage used in the 2023 bond rate with the numbers provided in the presentation slide on the 2026 preliminary debt rate.

- B. ID 25-1272 Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction on the adoption of the 2024 International Energy Conservation Code appendices for EV Ready and Solar Ready for all new construction. [Estimated Presentation/Discussion Time: 30 minutes]

The item was presented, and discussion followed.

Council requested staff to provide the drop-charges for old and new construction for installation of 110V and 220V type plugs in a garage.

Council Members Byrd, Jester and Holland supported staff recommendations to take no action to change the code. Council Member McGee supported the Health and Building Standards Commission (HABSCO) providing recommended incentives. Mayor Pro Tem Rumohr supported HABSCO providing examples of incentives versus no action. Council Member Beck asked to hear from the HABSCO Chair before giving his recommendation.

The Mayor denied the request.

Council Member Beck appealed.

Mayor Hudspeth denied the appeal.

Council Member McGee made a point of information regarding presentation of material to City Council upon request of Council in the past.

City Attorney Reinwand advised the Mayor, as Chair, has discretion to run the meeting and how Council may act to override the Chair's ruling.

Point of inquiry made by Council Member McGee regarding the process for Council to override the Chair's decision.

The City Attorney Reinwand provided clarification.

Council Member Beck gave direction for staff to take action to implement code changes as mandatory.

Mayor Hudspeth gave direction for staff to take no action resulting in a Council majority direction supporting staff's recommendation to make no changes to the code.

Council majority also (Mayor Hudspeth, Mayor Pro Tem Rumohr, and Council Members Beck and McGee) supported staff requesting HABSCO review the item again and provide findings that staff would present to Council at a future Work Session.

Point of Information made by Council Member Holland.

Clarification provided by Mayor Hudspeth.

HABSCO Chair Nick Stevens provided his comments to Council.

City Manager clarified staff will share this Work Session with HABSCO who may choose to make other recommendations with the understanding that this is not a direction of Council. Any incentives that may be recommended would be presented to the Sustainability Framework Advisory Committee.

The work session ended at 3:30 p.m.
