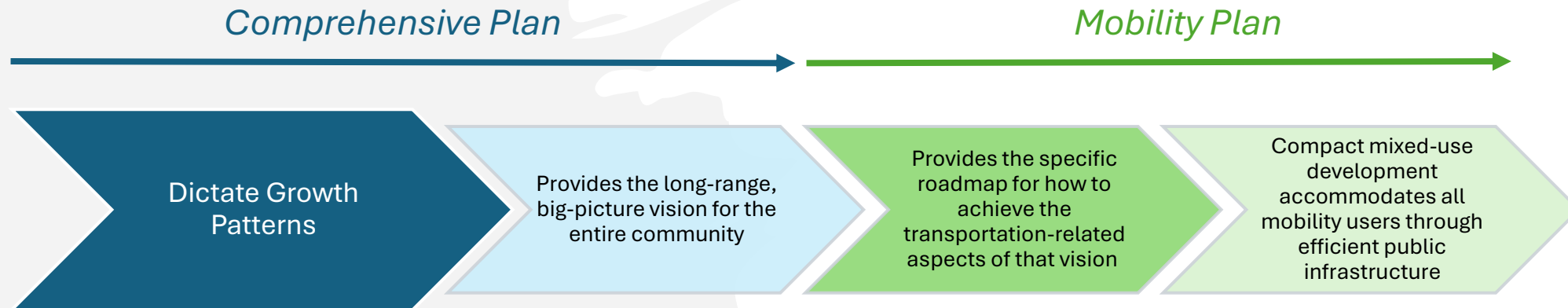

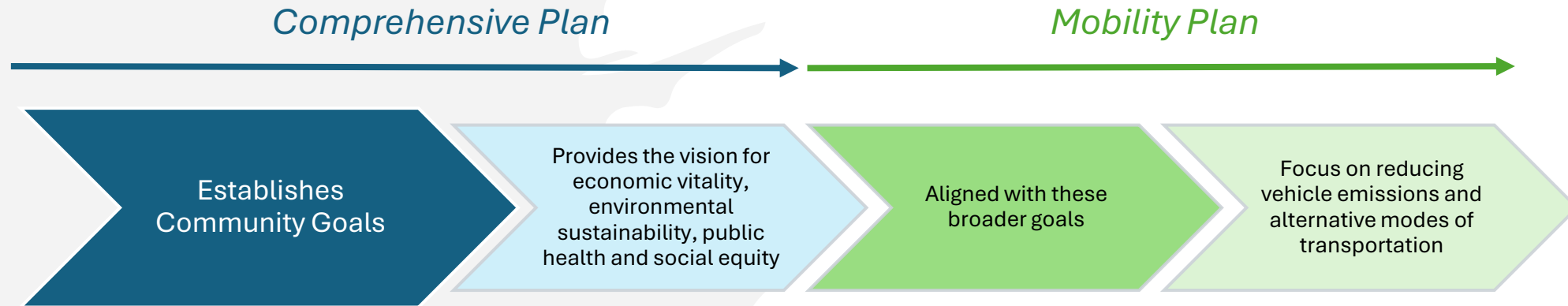

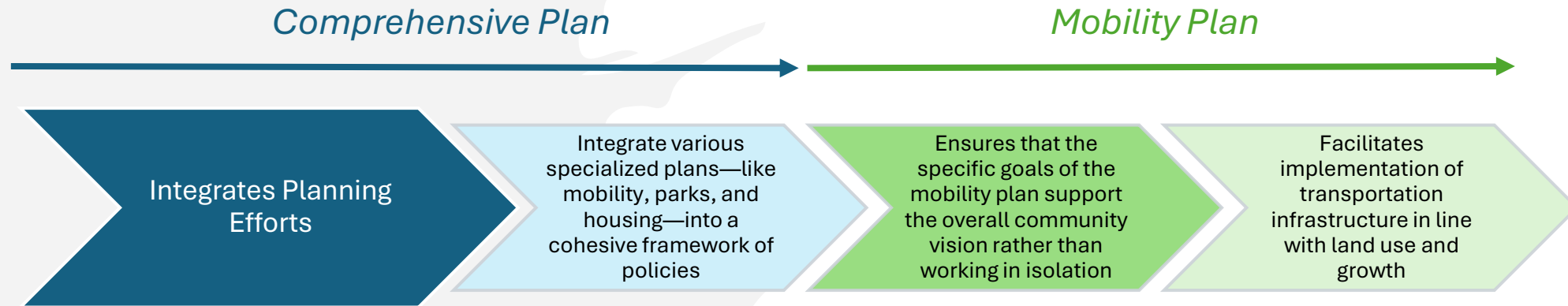
Mutual Dependency of the Two Plans – Growth Patterns



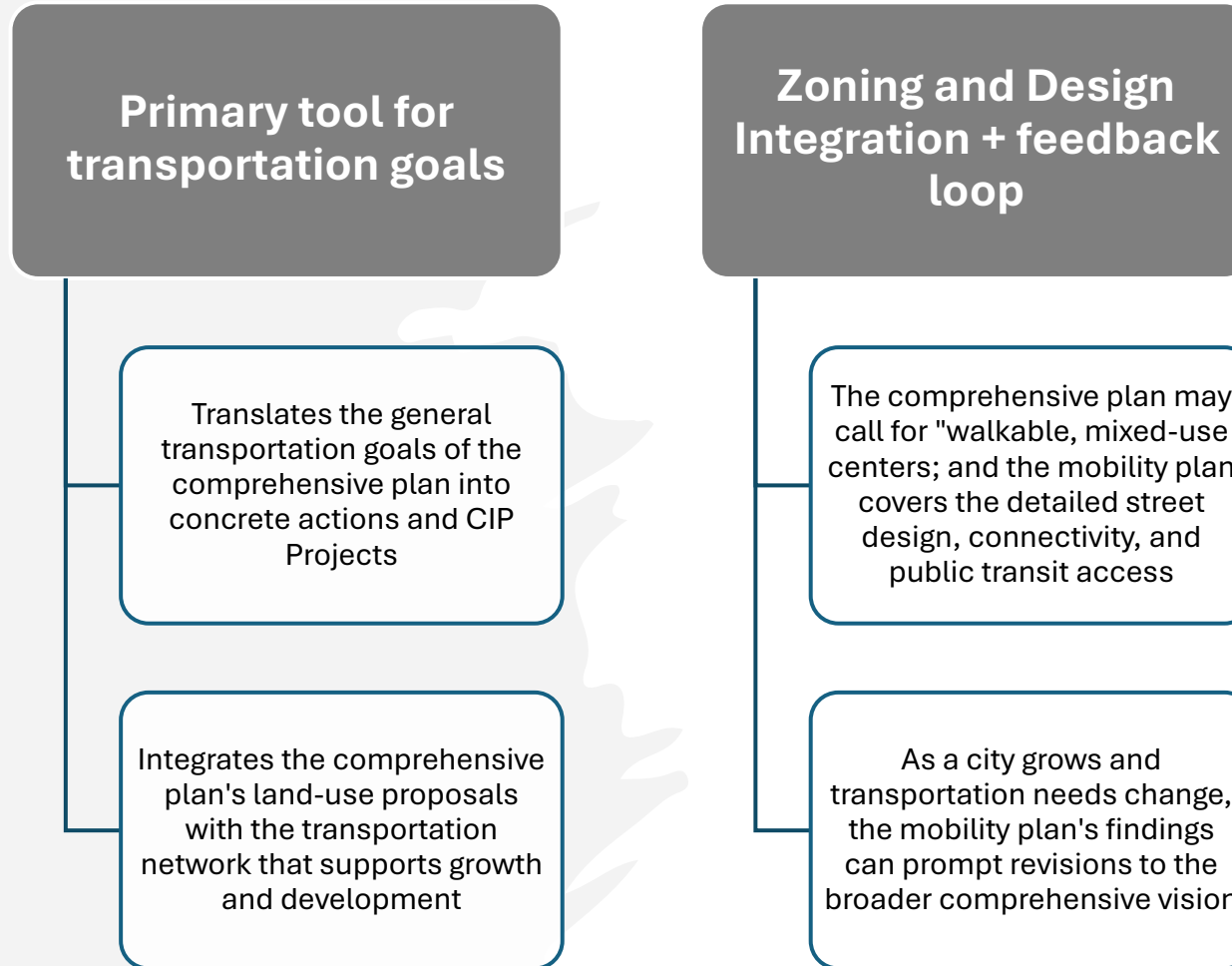
Mutual Dependency of the Two Plans –Community Goals

Why Aligning with Mobility Plan Is Important?



Working together around City of Denton Mobility Priorities

- **Respect for Prioritization** – Uphold the Mobility Plan’s priorities as the framework for decision-making, ensuring projects reflect established goals.
- **Data-Driven Approach** – Link interventions to critical needs using data and standards, while incorporating citizen and community requests in balance.
- **Need vs. Want** – Differentiate between critically needed improvements and desired enhancements to protect resources and focus impact.
- **Work Plan Alignment** – Support execution of Sidewalk, Bike Lane, and ADA Work Plans to prevent random or fragmented implementation.
- **Systematic Progress** – Avoid reactive approaches that divert staff and create future retrofit costs, ensuring steady and sustainable progress.
- **Comprehensive Plan Integration** – Connect mobility investments with broader land use and density goals to reduce vehicle reliance and promote multimodal opportunities.
- **Efficient Research** – Direct staff research inquiries toward priorities within the Mobility Plan, optimizing resources and outcomes.
