

Sec. 29-1. - International Fire Code—Adopted.

There is hereby adopted by the City of Denton, Texas for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire and explosion, those certain Codes and Standards known as the International Fire Code, including Appendices A—J, published by the International Code Council, Inc., being particularly the 2012 editions thereof and whole thereof, save and except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, modified or amended by section 29-2 of this chapter. A copy of said Fire Code is now filed in the office of the city secretary, and is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this ordinance shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the City of Denton and within five thousand (5,000) feet thereof, where specified therein.
