

ORDINANCE NO. 26-0189

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DENTON AND TEXAS WOMAN’S UNIVERSITY (TWU) TO PROVIDE FACILITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES AT THE DENTON SENIOR CENTER TO TWU STUDENTS TO SUPPORT THEIR ACQUISITION OF SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE RELATED TO THEIR CHOSEN FIELD OF STUDY OR OCCUPATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PERFORM ALL OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY UNDER THE AGREEMENT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Denton (the “City”) recognizes that Texas Woman’s University (TWU) provides academic courses to students including courses with hands-on experience

WHEREAS, TWU desires to provide students in certain courses with the hands-on experience of providing blood pressure and glucose screenings, a valuable service to the community and patrons at the Denton Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the Educational Experience Agreement outlines the responsibilities for each cooperating party to ensure quality service to the senior center patrons; and

WHEREAS, the Educational Experience Agreement will be effective from the time of execution until one year from the date of execution, at which point a new annual agreement will be signed by the City Manager or the designee; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denton City Council finds that it is the public interest to approve the Educational Experience Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The City of Denton City Council finds that the recitations contained in the preamble of this ordinance are incorporated herein by reference as true and as if fully set forth in the body of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to execute on behalf of the City the Educational Experience Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is further authorized to carry out all duties and obligations to be performed by the City under the Agreement.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
