AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF CENTRAL AVENUE BETWEEN MAPLE STREET AND EAGLE DRIVE, THE NORTH SIDE OF WILSHIRE STREET BETWEEN NORTH TEXAS BOULEVARD AND KENDOLPH STREET, AND THE DEAD-END SECTION OF SOUTH KENDOLPH STREET. THE GENERAL AREA OF FOCUS IS LOCATED EAST OF I-35 AND SOUTH OF UNT CAMPUS, CITY OF DENTON, TEXAS; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$200 FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING THAT VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE GOVERNED BY CHAPTER 18 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DENTON; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the University of North Texas's Facility and Maintenance Department has requested a parking restriction on the west side of Central Avenue between Maple Street and Eagle Drive, the north side of Wilshire Street between North Texas Boulevard and Kendolph Street, and the dead-end section of south Kendolph Street (hereafter, "the Restricted Areas"); and

WHEREAS, the presence of parked cars creates safety concerns for motorists, pedestrians, and students crossing the road, as well as hindering the traffic flow; and

WHEREAS, The Transportation Services Division reviewed the request for Restricted Areas and concluded that parking restrictions are necessary to enhance safety for pedestrians and cyclists, while also improving traffic flow; and

WHEREAS, City Council may instruct the traffic engineer to designate non-parking areas within the City pursuant to Chapter 18, Article IV, Sec. 18-96(a) of the Denton Code of Ordinances; NOW THEREFORE

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> The recitations contained in the preamble of this ordinance are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

SECTION 2: As of the effective date of this Ordinance and when signs and/or marking, or any combination thereof, are in place giving notice thereof, no person shall park on the west side of Central Avenue between Maple Street and Eagle Drive, the north side of Wilshire Street between North Texas Boulevard and Kendolph Street, and the dead-end section of south Kendolph Street.

SECTION 3: The provisions of Section 2 prohibiting the parking of vehicles shall apply on the designated portion of the above-named street, except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with the direction of a police officer or official traffic control device.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Denton in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance as related to the above parking restriction are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Denton not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this ordinance, or application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, and the City Council of the City of Denton hereby declares it would have enacted such remaining portions despite any invalidity.

<u>SECTION 6:</u> Save and except as amended hereby, all the provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of the Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7: Any person found liable of violating this Ordinance by a court of competent jurisdiction shall be fined a sum not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200). Each day that a provision of this ordinance is violated shall constitute a separate offense. The disposition of parking citations issued pursuant to this Ordinance shall be governed by Article IV, Division 3 titled "Parking Violations Division" of Chapter 18 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after the City Council approval for sign installation and providing for a penalty 30 days after sign installation, and the City Secretary is hereby directed to cause the caption of this ordinances to be published twice in the *Denton Record-Chronicle*, the official newspaper in the City of Denton, Texas, within 10 days of the date of its passage.
