BACKGROUND

The Simply Sustainable Framework was drafted in 2019 but not adopted until June of 2020. During the August 25, 2023 Sustainability Framework Advisory Committee meeting staff shared a plan to timeline the review the Simply Sustainable Framework (SSF) and prepare updates.

In today's meeting staff will review two focus areas with the Committee and request suggestions about how to update these areas.

The Framework includes Goals, Strategies and metrics. To better align with the new citywide performance tracking tool staff will be tailoring metrics as we work through the document.

- 2. Encourage and promote involvement of community members of all ages to further understanding of basic sustainability.
- 3. Increase sustainability education awareness and personal responsibility.
