

COMPANY BACKGROUND

- Leader in temperature-controlled storage and transportation logistics for many of the country's largest food providers.
- Existing Denton Company that has 37 existing facilities in 13 states.
- The company, which has operating for 126 years, started as American Ice Company in 1899, it was renamed to United States Cold Storage (USCS) in 1920 and became a wholly owned subsidiary of John Swire &

Sons in 1982.



BACKROUND: PRIOR INCENTIVE

- 2018: received a 50% cost share of the sales and use taxes for the construction of their distribution facility (Ord. 2018-1065).
- 2020: Received a Certificate of Occupancy.
- The electric demand of the company is 1.5 megawatts annually, which makes them a Top 25 customer for DME.
- 2023: Agreement was terminated, as the grantee did not obtain a Texas Direct Pay Permit and the City could not verify the sales taxes for the construction and equipping of the facility.



BUSINESS RETENTION AND EXPANSION

- The project is retaining 148 jobs in Denton
- 172 New jobs created to help support the local economy

SUPPLY CHAIN

 USCS is a transportation logistics company providing best in service, facilities, and is essential to the cold chain

SUSTAINABILITY

- Project Winter's CO2 emission reduction 11.4% for the company
- Goal to reach net zero emissions by 2050
- Food waste and sustainability program

GENERATES NEW UTILITY CUSTOMERS

 The Company is a high energy electric user for DME

INCENTIVE RECOMMENDATION

Chapter 380 Grant

- Performance-based ad valorem tax rebate at 60% for 8 years for the business expansion
- Sales and Use Tax for Construction Rebate at 75%
 - Agreement to include a valuation threshold and cap on funding amounts for each grant.
- An incentive would make the company eligible for Nomination to the state Texas Enterprise Zone Program (separate approval and compliance process).

STAFF RECOMENDATION

 Provide an 8-year, performance-based Chapter 380 incentive, total not to exceed \$1,067,871
