The site is located on the east side of Marietta Street, between W Oak Street and Houseton Place. (HL25-0001, 314 Marietta Street Historic Tax Exemption, Cameron Robertson)

Commissioner Treat made as motion of approval as presented with the additional stipulation to revisit framework of applications for concerns raised during discussion. Motion seconded by Commissioner Gregory. Motion carried.
