#### **SUBJECT**

Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, a Texas home-rule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with Techline, Inc., through the Lower Colorado River Authority Contract No. 6941, for the acquisition of electric maintenance, repair, and construction inventory for Denton Municipal Electric to be stocked in the Warehouse and at Denton Municipal Electric; providing for the expenditure of funds therefor; and providing an effective date (File 8947 – awarded to Techline, Inc., in the five (5) year not-to-exceed amount of \$6,000,000.00).

#### INFORMATION/BACKGROUND

The proposed contract is for the supply of electric distribution and transmission maintenance, repair, and operational supplies, which are used by Denton Municipal Electric (DME). This contract intends to supply low usage, one-time buy, and specialty items not covered by any current City agreements. The City will also be able to use this contract to purchase a variety of electric items such as wire, cable, hardware, connectors, splices, and other supplies used by DME.

The purchase of these incidental supplies is necessary so that DME can construct, operate, and maintain overhead and underground electric facilities and provide electric service to new and existing customers. Items are purchased as needed by the Warehouse and by DME. Based on a historical spend and future projections, the recommended not-to-exceed for this contract is \$6,000,000 for a total five (5) year contract.
