SUBJECT

Hold a public hearing to consider amending and updating the Water and Wastewater Land Use Assumptions and Capital Improvements Plan, and the imposition of increased water and wastewater impact fees for designated service areas, and discuss amending Ordinance No. 2019-008 regulating the City's water and wastewater impact fees.

STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT

This action supports Key Focus Area: Support Healthy and Safe Communities.

INFORMATION/BACKGROUND

The City of Denton is updating its Water and Wastewater Impact Fees in accordance with Chapter 395 of the Texas Local Government Code. Impact fees are a mechanism to recover the costs associated with expanding infrastructure necessary to serve new development.

The City first adopted impact fees in 1998. In accordance with Chapter 395 of the Texas Local Government Code, land use assumptions and capital improvement plans must be updated every five years. The city periodically updates its impact fees, with the last update completed in January 2019. The current update commenced in August 2022 and encompasses a defined service area, revised land use assumptions, service unit projections, and 10-year capital improvement plans (CIPs), which serve as the basis for calculating the maximum allowable impact fees.

On June 25, 2025, the Capital Improvements Advisory Committee (CIAC) voted 6-0 to recommend adopting the full cost recovery amount permitted under state law. Most recently, on July 15, 2025, City Council received an update during a work session and provided feedback on the proposed fees.

The 2025 Recovery Fee amounts per Single-Family Equivalent (SFE) are shown below:

The Capital Improvement Advisory Committee (CIAC) recommends 100% recovery; Staff recommends 75% recovery; City Council gave direction for 75% at the July 15, 2025 worksession.
