

Oncor Franchise Agreement

Background

- Non-exclusive franchise agreement is required for Oncor to operate in the City of Denton right of way
- Previous Franchise Agreement
 - Adopted: Dec. 18, 2012
 - Expired: Dec. 18, 2022
 - Provisions continued while City and Oncor negotiated new contract



Agreement

- New agreement has substantial similarities between the previous agreement and agreements between Oncor and other cities
- Agreement provides for (among other regulations):
 - Conditions when Oncor may place facilities in the right of way
 - Maintenance and relocation of Oncor infrastructure
 - Emergency repairs
 - Record retention by Oncor and access by the City
- New Agreement expires Sept. 30, 2043



Financial Information

- Oncor pay the City:
 - \$0.003002 per kilowatt hour of electricity delivered to customers within the City limits
 - Annual franchise fee of 4% on discretionary service charges
- Payments to City of Denton
 - January-December 2022: \$65,353
 - January-October: 2023: \$44,074



Next Steps

- City of Denton Charter requires agreement to be read and approved at three (3) <u>regular</u> meetings before it becomes effective.
 - First reading: Nov. 7, 2023
 - Second reading: Dec. 5, 2023
 - Third and final reading: Feb. 6, 2023
- When approved, the new franchise agreement will be effective immediately after its passage, publication, and accepted by Oncor.
