SUBJECT

Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding planned signage at the Forever Friends Memorial at North Lakes Dog Park.

BACKGROUND

This project is a collaboration between the City of Denton Parks and Recreation Department and the Denton Parks Foundation. Plans for a pet memorial at North Lakes Park first solidified in late 2025 with the Denton Parks Foundation taking the lead to raise money for the project.

The project anticipates the installation of a Pet Tribute Wall where residents and visitors can celebrate the memory of pets that have passed on by purchasing tags from the Denton Parks Foundation to affix to the Pet Tribute Wall. Funds raised from the sale of memorial tags will fund additional improvements to Denton parks. The expected cost of each memorial tag is \$15.

Denton Parks Foundation has provided preliminary text and graphic theming for signage at the Pet Tribute Wall (**Exhibit 2**). As well as a general schematic of the overall project.

The project is anticipated to be completed in Fall 2026.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommend approving the project direction and the thematic graphics and text for the Pet Tribute Wall.

The Pet Tribute Wall at North Lakes Park is made possible through the generosity of Denton Parks Foundation, Denton residents, and with administrative support from the City of Denton Parks and Recreation Department.

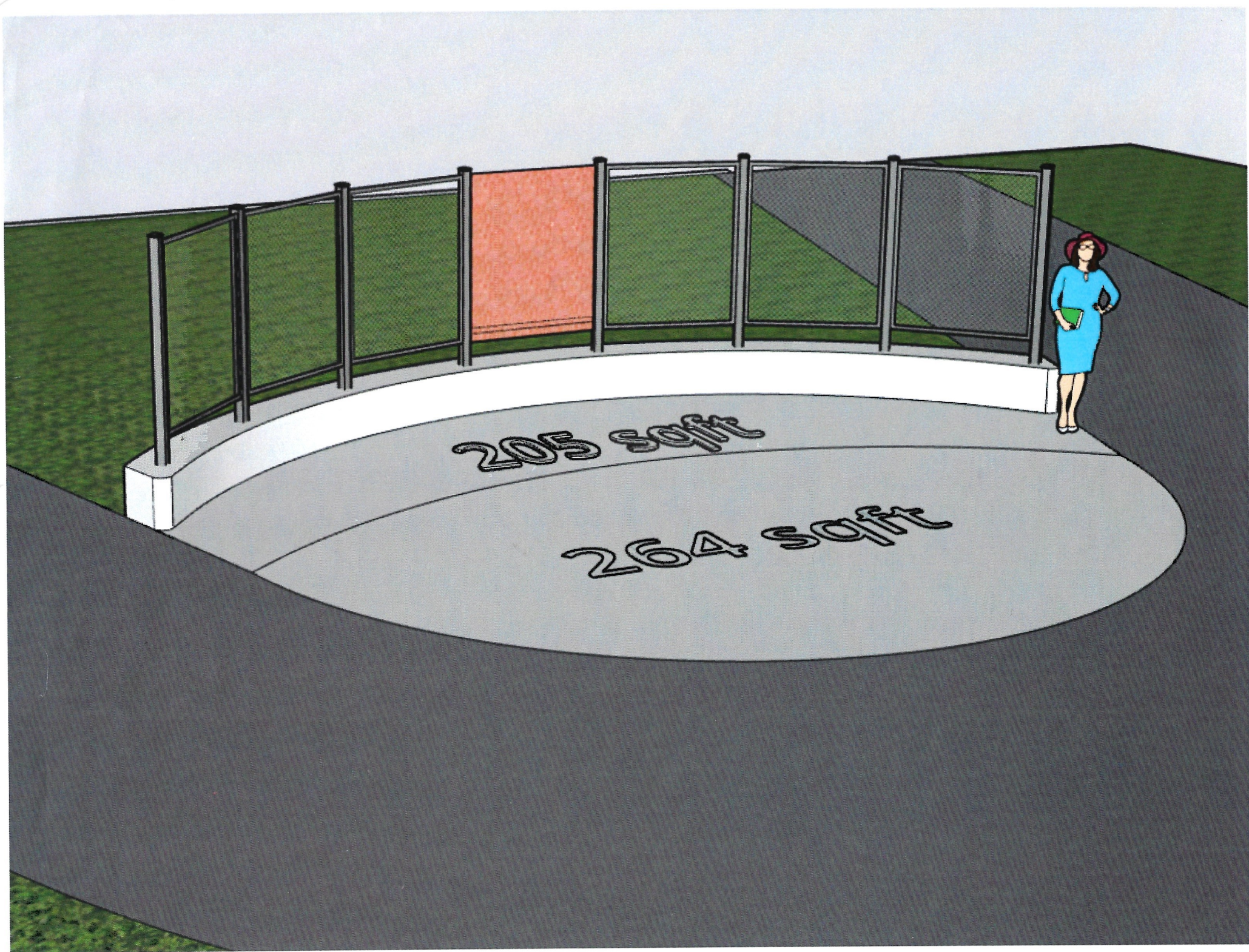

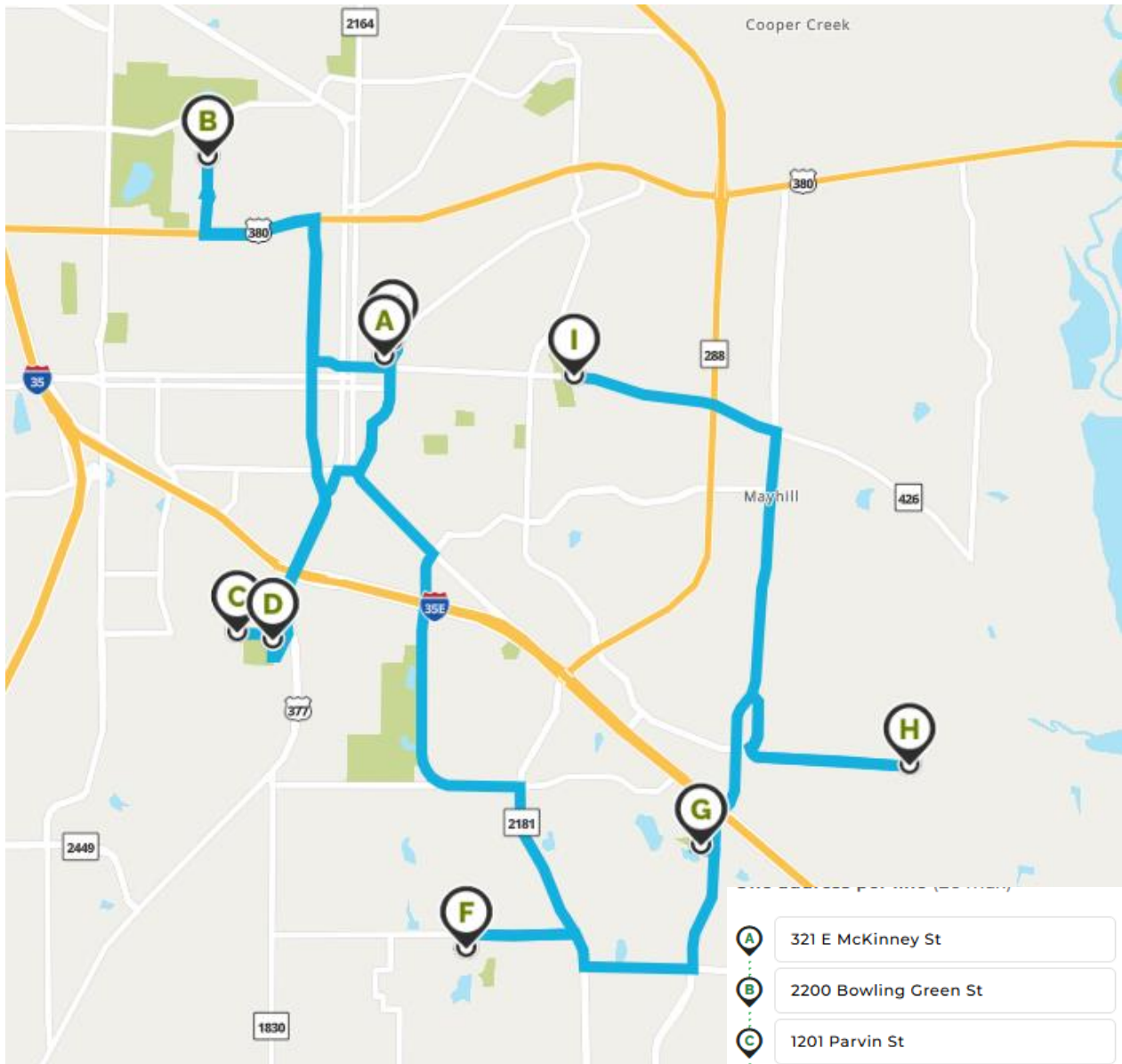
