AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON, A TEXAS HOME-RULE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CARAHSOFT TECHNOLOGY CORPORATION, THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES (DIR) COOPERATIVE CONTRACT NOS. DIR-CPO-5687 AND DIR-CPO-5683, AND THROUGH THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS) COOPERATIVE PROGRAM CONTRACT NO. 220105, FOR THE PURCHASE OF VARIOUS APPLICATION LICENSES, SOFTWARE SUBSCRIPTIONS, AND SOFTWARE AS A SERVICE FOR THE TECHNOLOGY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS THEREFOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (FILE 8854 – AWARDED TO CARAHSOFT TECHNOLOGY CORPORATION, IN THE FIVE (5) YEAR NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$3,266,000.00).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 20-196, the Texas Department of Information Resources Cooperative Contracts Program has solicited, received, and tabulated competitive bids for the purchase of necessary materials, equipment, supplies, or services in accordance with the procedures of state law and city ordinances; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2011-082, The Interlocal Purchasing System Program has solicited, received, and tabulated competitive bids for the purchase of necessary materials, equipment, supplies, or services in accordance with the procedures of state law and city ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, or a designated employee, has reviewed and recommended that the herein described materials, equipment, supplies, or services can be purchased by the City through the Texas Department of Information Resources and TIPS Cooperative Contracts Program at less cost than the City would expend if bidding these items individually; and

WHEREAS, this procurement was undertaken as part of the City's governmental function; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has provided in the City Budget for the appropriation of funds to be used for the purchase of the materials, equipment, supplies, or services approved and accepted herein; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The numbered items in the following numbered purchase order for materials, equipment, supplies, or services, shown in the "File Number" listed hereon, and on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent, are hereby approved:

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Should the City and persons submitting approved and accepted items set forth in the referenced file number wish to enter into a formal written agreement as a result of the City's ratification of bids awarded by Texas Department of Information Resources and TIPS Cooperative Contracts Program, the City Manager, or their designated representative, is hereby authorized to execute the written contract which shall be referenced herein; provided that the written contract is in accordance with the terms, conditions, specifications, and standards contained in the Proposal submitted to the Texas Department of Information Resources and TIPS Cooperative Contracts Program and related documents herein approved and accepted.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. By the acceptance and approval of the above enumerated bids, the City Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of funds therefore in the amount and in accordance with the approved bids.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
