SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton, Texas, a Home-Rule Municipal Corporation, authorizing the City Manager, or their designee, to execute an agreement for cost sharing of an offsite sewer line with UCRP Acquisitions, LLC, a Texas Limited Liability Company, wherein UCRP Acquisitions, LLC will pay its proportionate share of costs involving design, easement acquisition, surveying, engineering, potholing, construction, legal fees, and other associated matters for an offsite sanitary sewer line generally located at the intersection of Hampton Road and North Masch Branch Road and running south along North Masch Branch Road, under U.S. 380, and connecting to an existing line near Jim Christal Road; and providing an effective date.

BACKGROUND

The Wastewater Master Plan was adopted by Council on May 7, 2024; this included the Capital Project 13 – North Masch Sewer Line to serve the Hickory Creek service area with approximately 9,114 linear feet of sewer line public improvement, which requires onsite and offsite public utility easements.

The Harris Ranch Tract property is approximately 84.140 acres of land generally located north of US 380 and west of North I-35E in the City of Denton for proposed light industrial development and uses.

To expedite the construction of this City sewer line project, the Developer has agreed to fund the Developer's proportionate share of the cost of design, easement acquisition, surveying, engineering, potholing, construction, legal fees and all other associated costs of the Capital Project 13 – North Masch Sewer Line. This sewer line will be extended to serve the Harris Ranch Tract and other property not owned by the Developer, including future light industrial development to the south. Based on the agreement, the Developer would be contributing \$153,260.51 in funding to the Project which the City would otherwise have to fund fully. The City Council approved a similar agreement on December 16, 2025, for another developer to fund 9.95% (\$564,793.34) for the sewer line.

This line will serve approximately 1,100 acres of undeveloped land in that area, which could potentially be developed. This could be approximately 10.3 million SF of Light Industrial buildings and \$1 billion in future value. 4.7 million SF of this future development is currently in development review by the City and is intended to be served by this sewer line.
