These classes and events provide individuals with physical, intellectual, and developmental disabilities an opportunity to participate in recreation programs with their peers while enhancing physical, social, and emotional well-being. The entire community is invited to join in the fun.

The programs vary and are targeted to certain age groups. Example programs are indoor and outdoor sports, games and activities, outings and socials, dances, arts and crafts classes, and community involvement.
