A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DENTON RENAMING THE JUNETEENTH SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT TO THE JOHN ROYSTON JUNETEENTH SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution 20-2001 adopted October 20, 2020 outlines the City of Denton's application and policy guidelines for naming city buildings; facilities and land; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed the Parks, Recreation and Beautification Board to serve as the committee responsible for evaluation, discussion, and recommendations regarding applications with said recommendations submitted to the City Council for consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation, and Beautification Board received an application in support of renaming the Juneteenth Softball tournament to recognize the legacy of long-time umpire John Royster; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 2. The tournament previously known as the Juneteenth Softball Tournament is hereby renamed the John Royster Juneteenth Softball Tournament.
