SUBJECT

Consider a request by McAdams on behalf of Giving Grace Holdings, Inc for a Final Plat of the Giving Grace Addition. The 15.903-acre site is generally located south of East McKinney Street, approximately 990 feet east of Mayhill Road, in the City of Denton, Denton County, Texas. (FP25-0036a, Giving Grace Addition, Mia Hines)

BACKGROUND

The subject property is located just south of East McKinney Street, approximately 990 feet east of Mayhill Road. In 2022, a planned development was approved to allow for the development proposed multifamily development. Since this approval, the applicants have redesigned their proposed development plans to include two points of access. The purpose of this Final Plat is to establish one plated lot with easements consistent with the approved multifamily development plans for the subject property.
