To all to whom these presents shall come,

Greetings:

- WHEREAS,** April 1st through April 5th has been designated National Community Development Week to celebrate the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program now in its 50th year, and the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program now in its 34th year; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Denton has received \$36.9M from the CDBG program since 1984, and \$14.6M from the HOME program since 1994; and
- WHEREAS,** the CDBG Program provides annual funding and flexibility to local communities like the City of Denton to provide decent, safe, and affordable housing, a suitable living environment, and economic opportunities to low- and moderate-income communities; and
- WHEREAS,** the HOME Program provides funding to create and preserve decent, safe, and affordable housing opportunities for low-income persons; and
- WHEREAS,** CDBG and HOME foster a strong network among local government, residents, businesses, and nonprofit organizations working to meet the needs of residents, and the City of Denton has clearly demonstrated the capacity to administer the CDBG and HOME Programs to identify, prioritize and resolve pressing problems.
- NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Gerard Hudspeth, Mayor of the City of Denton, Texas, do hereby declare and proclaim this week of April 1st through 5th, 2024, as

in the City of Denton and encourage all citizens to support these two valuable programs that have made tremendous contributions to the sustainability of the housing stock, infrastructure, public services, and economic vitality of our community.
