### **SUBJECT**

Consider approval of a resolution of the City Council of the City of Denton for the appointment of one member to the Board of Managers of the Denco Area 9-1-1 District for a two-year term beginning on October 1, 2024 and ending on September 30, 2026; and providing an effective date.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Denco Area 9-1-1 District was created in 1987 and is governed by a board of managers appointed by the County, participating cities, and the Denton County Fire Chief's Association. Each year, the term of one of the two members appointed by participating municipalities expires. This year, the term of Jim Carter expires on September 30, 2024. Mr. Carter is seeking reelection. Board members serve in two-year staggered terms and are eligible for reappointment.

On June 3, 2024 the City received notice (Exhibit 2) from Denco requesting that the City vote for one of the nominees on the slate of nominees and advise them of its selection, if any, prior to July 31, 2024. Two nominees for the position were submitted by area cities. The nominees are Jim Carter and Greg Kohn. The resumes of the nominees are included in Exhibit 2. The nominee with the most votes will be the municipalities' representative to the District's Board of Managers for the two-year term beginning October 1, 2024.
