SUBJECT

Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction, on the installation of an identification sign for the area in Evers Park currently occupied by the Scouting America Troop 65.

BACKGROUND

In 1967, Boy Scout Troop 65, sponsored by the First United Methodist Church of Denton, Inc. (FUMC), established its "Boy Scout Hut" on the south side of Evers Park where it has conducted boy scout activities since that time. In August 2003, the Scout troop entered into a license agreement (Ordinance #2003-257) with the City of Denton, outlining terms to exercise certain rights and privileges upon the property at Evers Park. Within this agreement, modifications to the surrounding grounds must be approved by the City prior to being completed.

City staff was recently approached by the troop leader to request the installation of a new sign at the entry along Windsor Dr. to help with visibility and prominence of their facility. Staff and the scouts propose using a sign that resembles other city park signs and installing it in a location that allows for future sidewalks and/or trails to be constructed without potentially disturbing the sign in the future.

OPTIONS

Recommend approval of the sign layout, design, and placement.
Recommend denial of the sign layout, design, and placement.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommend approval of the sign layout, design, and placement.
