Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) is a leadership training experience conducted by Rotary Clubs and Districts worldwide since the program was sanctioned by Rotary International in 1971. Rotary District 5790, consisting of 71 clubs across the North Central Texas Region is conducting a RYLA Camp in Denton, Texas for the 18th year during the period 14-17 June. The Camp will include 120 high school junior and senior participants plus adult counselors. The Camp is housed at Texas Woman's University (TWU) with activities on and off campus.

Each year the RYLA Camp program includes some activities in conjunction with the City of Denton including a Mock City Council and a service project. The service project this year is planned at the City's Clear Creek Natural Heritage Center on Saturday June 16. One -half of the students/counselors in the morning and one-half in the afternoon. The RYLA Program is requesting the City of Denton provide some in-kind service in the form of transportation to and from the Clear Creek Natural Heritage Center as it is some distance from TWU.
