

RESOLUTION NO. 25-1948

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DENTON APPOINTING A PRIMARY REPRESENTATIVE AND AN ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DENTON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 460.201 of the Texas Transportation Code sets the term of a Board of Director member at two years and authorizes the governing body of the City of Denton to appoint one board member to the Board of Directors of the Denton County Transportation Authority (the "Authority Board") to fill the vacancy in the same manner as the original appointment of the interim executive committee under Section 460.054(b)(1); and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the public interest to appoint _____ as the primary representative for the City of Denton to the Authority Board to serve the term to begin November 13, 2025 and to expire on November 12, 2027; and to appoint _____ as the alternate representative for the City of Denton to the Authority Board to serve the term to begin November 13, 2025 and to expire on November 12, 2027; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The findings and recitations contained in the preamble of this Resolution are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. _____ is hereby appointed as the primary representative to the Authority Board for the City of Denton, to serve in such capacity for the term to begin November 13, 2025 and to expire on November 12, 2027. This person is qualified to serve on the Authority Board as having professional experience in the field of transportation, business, government, engineering, or law.

SECTION 3. _____ is hereby appointed as the alternate representative to the Authority Board to serve in such capacity for the term to begin November 13, 2025 and to expire November 12, 2027. This person is qualified to serve on the Authority Board as having professional experience in the field of transportation, business, government, engineering, or law.

SECTION 4. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to send a certified copy of this Resolution to appropriate officials of the Denton County Transportation Authority.

SECTION 5. All previous and order, or parts of resolutions or orders, in force when the provision of this Resolution become effective which are inconsistent or in conflict or in conflict with the terms or provision contained in this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
