Parcel #1 – Open Space


• 2.273 acres = \$1,584,000

Parcel #2 - Courts


• 1.160 acres = \$985,000

- \$2,569,000 land appraisal




Parcel #1 – Open Space





Parcel #2 - Courts




City of Denton South Lakes Park

- \$1,740,000 land appraisal




Parcel #1 – Open Space



Value to Denton Park System

- High impact to 10-Minute Walk Initiative
- This area is identified in the PARD Land Plan
- Increases access by2.1% (57.4% to 59.5%)
- Adds a total of 3,210 residents within 10minute walk to a park
