AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF TEXAS, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, 2025 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT PROGRAM FUNDED THROUGH THE US DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$137,338.33 FOR MOBILE BARRICADES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Denton was notified of its eligibility for the 2025 UASI grant program and applied for said grant within the timeframes required by the application process; and

WHEREAS, the grant is awarded by the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, and funded by the US Department of Homeland Security for the period of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to support state and local efforts to prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events and prepare for the threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security of Texas citizens; and

WHEREAS, timely application for the grant was made April 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the grant will provide necessary equipment to implement mobile barricades to enhance the security at multiple locations throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the public to ratify the application for and to accept the grant award for the period of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. The recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct legislative and factual determinations of the City of Denton and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance and made a part hereof for all purposes as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The application for the 2025 UASI grant program made April 8, 2025, is hereby ratified.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is designated, delegated, and authorized to request and accept grant funding under the 2025 grant, including the submission of the grant application, and act on behalf of the City of Denton in all matters related to the grant application and any subsequent grant contracts and grant projects that may result.

<u>Section 4</u>. The City shall comply with the requirements of the Texas Office of the Governor, the US Department of Homeland Security, and the State of Texas.

<u>Section 5</u>. The project funds and any project-funded equipment and facilities will be used solely for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.

<u>Section 6</u>. The City agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

<u>Section 7</u>. This ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage.
