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Dedication Details

- 1. Developer to dedicate 4.274 acres from Northpointe Phase 6.
- 2. City to reimburse fee in lieu of land dedication for phase 7 & 8 for dedication, \$34,426.38. (Developer still responsible for park development fees in the amount of \$18,333.00.)

New park land will provide the city the opportunity to extend the existing trail (located south) to connect to Nicosia St. and new Loop 288 trail. (Next Slide)

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Benefits to City

- ✓ Expands Cooper Creek Trail across Hercules Ln.
- ✓ Allows the connection towards Nicosia St. and future Loop 288 10' trail and to Discovery Park
- ✓ Neighborhood Linear Park for surrounding area
- ✓ 10-minute walk campaign does not expand. (57.4%) However, extension of trail addresses gaps in trail system.
- ✓ Project in line with the 2023 Bond program for Trails
- ✓ Parks, Recreation and Trails System Master Plan
- ✓ PARD Land Plan
- ✓ Denton 2040 Plan





Direction and Next Steps

- Seeking approval of Development Agreement by City Council
 - September 9, 2024: Parks, Recreation, and Beautification Board approved (5-0)
- PARD will add this parcel to existing mowing contracts
- Design trail connection with trail bond funds
- Apply for TPWD grant funding up to \$300,000 to offset construction costs or move directly to construction with the support of trail bond funds
