A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DENTON APPOINTING AN ALTERNATE MEMBER TO THE DALLAS REGIONAL MOBILITY COALITION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Dallas Regional Mobility Coalition Bylaws outline the board composition and states, in part, "...the Executive Committee shall consist of appointed members as indicated ... one each from the Cities with a population of 50,000, ..., being either the Mayor or another elected official designated by the City Council."

WHEREAS, Dallas Regional Mobility Coalition Bylaws do not provide for a term limit for appointed members; and

WHEREAS, the City Council understands the important work performed by the Dallas Regional Mobility Coalition and therefore wishes to appoint an alternate member to fill the existing vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after due consideration, has selected Council Member Jill Jester to serve as alternate member on the Dallas Regional Mobility Coalition;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The recitations in the preamble of this resolution are incorporated by reference as findings of the City Council.

SECTION 2. Council Member Jill Jester is appointed as the alternate member of the Dallas Regional Mobility Coalition to represent the City of Denton.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
