### **SUBJECT**

Consider recommending adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton (“City”), a Texas home rule municipal corporation, authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Little Elm (“Little Elm”) concerning delivery of specified tonnage to the City’s Landfill by Little Elm at a discount disposal rate (“Interlocal Agreement”); and providing an effective date.

### **BACKGROUND**

Between approximately October 1, 2022, and September 20, 2024, the City of Denton maintained contracts with three private companies and two municipalities to provide over 210,000 tons of waste to the City of Denton Landfill; generating over \$7.8 million in revenue over the life of the contracts. Over the next two (2) years, the City of Denton, Solid Waste and Recycling Department, seeks to receive guaranteed, predictable tonnages of solid waste for both revenue and management purposes.

Little Elm is a current landfill customer with an account in good standing. Little Elm has committed to the delivery of up to 1,900 tons of solid waste annually in consideration of a discounted disposal charge of \$38.00 per ton, representing \$72,200.00 in annual revenue to the Solid Waste fund.

This agreement has been backdated to be effective October 1, 2024, consistent with the City’s waste hauler agreements. It will be reviewed and trued up annually, including an annual inflation escalator, and provide for two years of revenue to assist in achieving the goal of rate stabilization for the Solid Waste fund.
