






- On February 6, 2025, the Downtown Economic Development Committee (DEDC) reviewed and scored the grant application. The application scored an average of 26 points, making the business eligible for a reimbursement of up to \$35,000.
- On March 26, 2025, the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number One Board (TIRZ #1), reviewed the application and voted to recommend City Council approve the Downtown Reinvestment Grant for 227 W. Oak, The Plot Twist, for an amount not to exceed \$35,000.
