AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FY 2025 SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL GRANT PROGRAM FUNDED BY THE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT (IIJA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$960,000 AND CITY'S MATCHING FUNDS OF \$192,000 TO DEVELOP AN ADA TRANSITION PLAN, MOBILITY AND ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN, AND A SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PLAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) authorized and appropriated \$1 billion to be awarded by the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) for the FY 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program, and

WHEREAS, the USDOT opened the FY 2025 SS4A grant program application on March 28, 2025, for planning projects that will improve roadway safety by reducing and eliminating roadway fatalities and injuries through safety action plan development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denton is eligible to apply as a political subdivision of a State defined as a unit of government under the authority of State law including cities; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A grant program requires a twenty percent (20%) local matching share of eligible project costs and the city's matching costs are estimated at \$192,000, and

WHEREAS, the City has developed the necessary application materials and desires to make an application to the FY 2025 SS4A grant program; and

WHEREAS, grant applications are due on June 26, 2025; NOW, THEREFORE,

## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The recitals set forth above are found to be true and correct legislative and factual determinations of the City of Denton and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance and made a part hereof for all purposes as if fully set forth herein.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The application for the FY 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program is hereby authorized.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. The City Manager, or designee, is designated, delegated, and authorized to request grant funding under the USDOT FY 2025 SS4A grant program, including the submission of USDOT's application information and materials, and act on behalf of the City of Denton in all matters related to the grant application and any subsequent grant contracts and grant projects that may result.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. Should the project be funded, then the City of Denton shall comply with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Transportation.
