AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A REIMBURSEMENT GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FISCAL YEAR 2024 SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$576,000 IN FEDERAL FUNDING WHICH REQUIRES CITY MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$144,000, TO DEVELOP A VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN AND CONDUCT SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT PLANNING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) authorized and appropriated \$1 billion to be awarded by the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) for the FY 2024 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denton applied for a planning project that will improve roadway safety by reducing and eliminating roadway fatalities and injuries through safety action plan development; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded \$576,000 in federal funding to develop a Vision Zero Action plan and conduct supplemental project planning; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A grant program requires a 20 percent local matching share of eligible project costs and the City's matching costs will be \$144,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires the City Manager, or their designee, to execute on behalf of the City of Denton all contracts and related documents with USDOT, and such other parties as shall be necessary and appropriate for the development of a Vision Zero Action Plan and to take all such further action necessary to accomplish the project: NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The findings and recitals contained in the preamble of this ordinance are incorporated herein by reference as true and as if fully set forth in the body of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The City hereby authorizes the City Manager, or their designee, to execute on behalf of the City all contracts and related documents with USDOT, for the financial assistance and development of the project.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or their designee, is further authorized to carry out all duties and responsibilities to be performed by the City under the offer for the completion of the project, including, but not limited to, the expenditure of funds.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
