Why Should the City Issue Firearms?

- **\$3,000 – 5,000 out of pocket for a new hire**
 - Handgun with optic
 - Rifle with flashlight, optic, and sling
- **Current officers would incur an expense if weapons were standardized but not issued.**
- **Comparative cities issue firearms**
- **Avoid current problems**
 - Simunition gun & holster compatibility
 - Outdated weapons
 - Lack of standardization
 - Lack of replacement weapons
- **Available funding within Police Confiscation Fund**
