ORDINANCE NO. 25-1470

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON, A TEXAS HOME-RULE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS FOR THE REDESIGN COSTS IN CONNECTION WITH FUTURE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR A PARCEL NEAR LOOP 288 EAST AND GEESLING ROAD ASSOCIATED WITH THE LOOP 288 EAST-US 380 CONNECTOR PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$75,000.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Denton County (the "County") and the City of Denton (the "City") mutually desire to enter into an agreement to provide redesign costs in connection with future right-of-way for a parcel near Loop 288 East and Geesling Road associated with the TxDOT Loop 288 East-US 380 Connector Project (the "Project"), located entirely in the municipal limits of the City and Denton County Commissioner Precinct #1; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of completion for the Project is Seventy-Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$75,000.00), with the County agreeing to contribute an amount which shall not exceed Seventy-Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$75,000.00), based on current available funding, toward satisfactory completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 791 (the "Act"), provides authorization for a local government to contract with one or more local governments to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act, and the County and the City hereby mutually agree to be subject to the provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City finds that the receipt of funding for this redesign and redistribution to the developer of the Project is in the best interest of the City to assist in timely and efficient Project delivery as well as provide for the future development of the City as a result of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County and City value the timely completion of the Project which involves roads which are an integral part of the County's road system, and are undertaking the Project to facilitate safe travel on an improved roadway; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The recitals contained in the preamble of this ordinance are hereby incorporated into the body of this ordinance are true and correct.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The City Manager, or their designated representative, is hereby authorized to execute the written contract which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. The City Council of the City, hereby expressly delegates the authority to take any actions that may be required or permitted to be performed by the City under this ordinance to the City Manager of the City, or their designee.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of funds therefor in the amount and in accordance with the written contract attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B and to further provide the amount provided for the redesign by County to the developer of the relevant tract in the area of the Project.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
