REGULAR MEETING

1. ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

A. DCRC26-024: Consider approval of the minutes of the March 23, 2026 Development Code Review Committee Regular Meeting.

B. DCRC26-025: Consider approval of the minutes of the April 13, 2026 Development Code Review Committee Regular Meeting.

C. DCRC26-033: Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding proposed Code amendments related to Manufactured Housing.

Ashley Eskedt, Associate Planner, presented the item.

The Committee inquired on the history of the current regulations, the differences between modular homes and manufactured homes and discussed how the proposed regulations could be made more permissible in the future.

The Committee provided consensus to move forward with staff's recommendations as presented and requested staff bring the item back and provide additional affordable options as part of a separate update in the future.

D. DCRC26-032: Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction regarding a proposed new land use category related to unmanned aerial vehicles (“drones”).

Angie Manglaris, Assistant Planning Director, presented the item.

The Committee provided consensus to discuss setbacks in more detail at future meetings. Member Pruett suggested to investigate horizontal noise mitigation, avoiding impacting uses other than commercial drone use, and requested an overview of aerial logistics from recent meetings with the University of North Texas Center of Logistics.

The Committee generally provided consensus to move forward with creating the new definitions and assigning zoning to the uses presented. The Committee requested staff bring the item back and provide additional information and clarification on amendments needed to move forward.

Angie Manglaris, Assistant Planning Director, presented the item. Discussion followed.
