AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR PAYMENT BY THE CITY OF DENTON FOR THE ANNUAL CONSOLIDATED WATER QUALITY FEE TO THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR OPERATION OF THE PECAN CREEK WATER RECLAMATION PLANT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (FILE 6693-CONSOLIDATED WATER QUALITY FEE IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$110,257.93).

WHEREAS, Section 26.0291 of the Texas Water Code requires each wastewater discharge permit holder to pay a Water Quality Fee in order for the State to cover costs of inspections and enforcement of the Water Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denton operates the Pecan Creek Water Reclamation Plant within the City of Denton and holds a wastewater discharge permit for such operation; therefore, the City of Denton is required to pay such fees imposed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality set forth in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has reviewed and recommended that the City Council approve and authorize the immediate payment of these required fees to continue wastewater plant operation; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$110,257.93 to be paid to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality in the specified amount shown on Exhibit A, which is attached to and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.


