

Scope of Operations – Colin McCabe - CFI

This document outlines the intended flight operations to be conducted at Denton Enterprise Airport (DTO). The primary focus is on providing comprehensive flight instruction.

1. Dual Flight Instruction

Provision of dual flight instruction to aspiring pilots seeking various certifications and ratings. This includes:

- **Private Pilot Rating (PPL):** Comprehensive ground and flight instruction for individuals pursuing their initial pilot certification, enabling them to fly for personal use.
- **Instrument Rating (IR):** Specialized instruction focusing on instrument flight rules (IFR) and operations, allowing pilots to fly in a wider range of weather conditions.
- **Commercial Pilot Rating (CPL):** Advanced instruction designed for pilots aiming to fly for compensation or hire, covering complex maneuvers, aerodynamics, and professional pilot responsibilities.

2. Flight Reviews and Instrument Proficiency Checks

Offering essential recurrent training and evaluations to ensure pilot currency and proficiency. This includes:

- **Flight Reviews (FR):** Periodic flight and ground instruction required by the FAA to maintain pilot currency, covering general operating rules and maneuvers.
- **Instrument Proficiency Checks (IPC):** Evaluations for instrument-rated pilots to ensure continued proficiency in instrument flight procedures and regulations.

3. General Flying for Pleasure

Facilitation of personal recreational flying activities. This encompasses:

- Local flights for enjoyment and leisure.
- Maintaining pilot proficiency through personal practice and recreational sorties.
