Greetings:

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program is now in its 51st year, and the HOME

Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program now in its 35th year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denton has received \$39.2M from the CDBG program since 1984, and \$16.9M from

the HOME program since 1994; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Program provides annual funding to local communities to provide safe and affordable

housing, a suitable living environment, and economic opportunities to low- and moderate-income citizens, while the HOME Program provides funding to create affordable housing opportunities for

low-income households; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denton's CDBG and HOME allocations have funded 679 programs, repaired 1,716

homes, helped 590 first-time home buyers, and served 313,752 people across public services,

public infrastructure and housing projects; and

WHEREAS, CDBG and HOME foster a strong network among local government, residents, businesses and

nonprofit organizations working to meet the needs of Denton residents.
