So the text is quite clear that both answers work to be the goal of the health program.

**Department Response:** Accept all answers.

The risk management process is never described in sequential "steps," and it is not described as a "process." The text states on page 370, "At a minimum, the plan shall include risk identification, risk prioritization, risk evaluation, risk control techniques, and risk monitoring." Then later on the page, the text states, "NFPA 1500, 4.2.3 contains the five elements of a risk analysis: identification, evaluation, prioritization, control, and monitoring." Then on page 371, there is a graphic depicting a "risk management process" showing a circle with words identification, evaluation, priorities for action, control techniques, and monitoring (no steps) and the text for the graphic states, "The risk management plan cycles through five steps outlines in NFPA 1500."
