SUBJECT: Committee Requested Project Updates

This memo provides information and updates from staff relating to updates to the Committee on items of interest discussed in past meetings. The following is a listing and brief staff response to the matters brought forward.

Sidepath Work Plan Update:

Staff is developing and calibrating the bicycle lanes and pedestrian project prioritization criteria. Once the criteria are finalized, staff intends to create a prioritized project list for inclusion in the sidewalk work plan. Staff will present the bicycle lane and pedestrian project prioritization and deliverable timeline at the Mobility Committee meeting on December 17, 2025.

Transportation Services Future City Council Items:

- January 13 City Council
 - CA 25-2287: Staff conducted a traffic speed analysis on Mayhill Road and recommends to adjust and conform the speed limit for both northbound and southbound traffic to 40 miles per hour. This adjustment aligns with the speed limit proposed in the Mobility Plan 2022, as Mayhill Road is designated as a Primary Arterial.
 - CA 25-2288: Sam Houston Elementary School, Parents and Southridge residents reached out to Transportation Services to request an extension of the school's speed limit zone to the west of Pennsylvania Drive. This extension aims to provide a safe passage for students who walk or bike to school. After a thorough study, staff recommends extending the school speed limit zone and installing a sign 300 feet west of Pennsylvania Drive during school pick-up and drop-off hours.

FY25 Annual Total Lane Miles:

In the fiscal year 2024-2025, the City completed a total of 50.53 miles, including 37.72 lane miles completed by Capital projects and 24.27 lane miles completed by private development.

December 20, 2023 Mobility Minutes:
