

Proposal Summary

Proposal: Amend the Denton Code of Ordinances

Purpose:

Two bills adopted by the 89th Regular Legislative Session impact existing COO regulations. The proposed changes are intended to ensure the City's regulations correspond to state law, including:

- Address "familial status" as a basis for maximum dwelling occupancy and overcrowding and associated definitions (SB 1567)
- Clarify protest procedures for zoning changes which increase residential development or modify some or all
 existing zoning districts. These city-initiated "comprehensive zoning changes" and property owner-initiated
 rezoning requests have alternate protest thresholds (HB 24)
