AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON, TEXAS APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DENTON, A TEXAS HOME-RULE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AND TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY RELATING TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF STATE LAWS ON UNIFORM COMMERCIAL VEHICLE WEIGHT ENFORCEMENT WITHIN THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE CHAPTER 621, SUBCHAPTER F; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the established parameters for enforcement of defined State laws within the Transportation Code, Chapter 621, Subchapter F have been established, and the City of Denton, Texas (“City”) and the Texas Department of Public Safety would like to maximize uniform enforcement of provisions of said statute; and

WHEREAS, the attached Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (“Agreement”) specifies responsibilities of the City and the Texas Department of Public Safety, including but not limited to training, certification requirements, approved scale use, annual scale re-calibration, violation report requirements, and mandated reporting; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that this Agreement is in the best interests for the safety of the citizens of the City of Denton, and that a valid governmental purpose is served by said designation; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement on behalf of the City of Denton with the Texas Department of Public Safety, relating to the enforcement of state laws on uniform commercial vehicle weight enforcement within the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 621, Subchapter F, which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
