### **SUBJECT**

Receive a report, hold a discussion and provide direction regarding Regional Transportation Council monthly reports and actions.

### **BACKGROUND**

The purpose of this agenda item is to provide Mayor Pro Tem Bagheri, City of Denton Representative on the Regional Transportation Council (RTC), an opportunity to provide an update to the Mobility Committee regarding RTC monthly business. As part of the March 8, 2018 meeting, RTC staff presented information on the Mobility 2045 Plan (Exhibit 2). The targeted approval of the Mobility 2045 Plan in June 2018 has an impact on the City of Denton, specifically the advancement of the Loop 288 West project as well as capacity improvements on I-35E and I-35W. Attached, as Exhibit 3 is a PowerPoint presentation provided by RTC staff on the Draft Mobility 2045 Plan, the regional long-term transportation plan. John Polster, ITS and staff will facilitate the discussion on this item.

### **STRATEGIC PLAN RELATIONSHIP**

The City of Denton's Strategic Plan is an action-oriented road map that will help the City achieve its vision.
