

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DENTON NOMINATING A MEMBER TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DENTON CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Denton Central Appraisal District (DCAD) notified the City of Denton Place 4 of the DCAD Board of Directors was vacated by the passing of Board Member Ann Pomykal on February 13, 2026; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Tax Code, Title 1, Subtitle B, Chapter 6 , Subchapter A, Section 6.0301 (f) “If a vacancy occurs in an appointive position on the board of directors, each taxing unit that is entitled to vote under Section 6.03 may nominate by resolution adopted by its governing body a candidate to fill the vacancy. The taxing unit shall submit the name of its nominee to the chief appraiser within 45 days after notification from the board of directors of the existence of the vacancy, and the chief appraiser shall prepare and deliver to the board of directors within the next five days a list of the nominees. The board of directors shall appoint by majority vote of its members one of the nominees to fill the vacancy.”; and

WHEREAS, each jurisdiction may nominate by resolution a candidate to be considered for the DCAD Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, to be eligible to serve on the Board, an individual must be a resident of the district (Denton County) and must have resided in the district for at least two years immediately preceding the date they take office. Members cannot be an employee of a taxing unit served by the appraisal district and cannot be related to an employee of the appraisal district; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The recitals which are set forth in the preamble of this Resolution are incorporated herein and are made part of this Resolution for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City of Denton hereby nominates the following individual as a member to the Board of Directors of the Denton Central Appraisal District.
