

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DENTON, A TEXAS HOME-RULE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE FORMS FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGISTRATION, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES RELATED TO THE FACILITIES MANAGEMENT AND FLEET SERVICES DEPARTMENTS FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS; RATIFYING PREVIOUSLY EXECUTED FORMS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City's Facilities Management and Fleet Services departments manage City buildings, vehicles, and related infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City must regularly complete and submit regulatory forms to state and environmental agencies regarding day-to-day operations; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to delegate authority to City Manager, or their designee, to execute these routine forms without further City Council direction; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is the public interest to authorize the City Manager, or their designee, to execute these documents administratively; NOW, THEREFOR,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The recitations contained in the preamble of this ordinance are incorporated herein by reference as findings of the City Council.

SECTION 2. The City Council approves and authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute any forms required by the Texas Department of Licensing and Registration, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles related to the day-to-day operation of City facilities and vehicles without further authority, guidance, or direction from the City Council, and is further authorized to carry out the rights, duties, obligations, and responsibilities of the City with respect to such forms.

SECTION 3. The City Council approves and authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to take such additional actions as the City Manager or designee determines to be necessary and advisable to continue to effectuate the purpose, terms and conditions of such forms.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby ratifies previously executed forms approved of by City staff.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
