ORDINANCE NO. 25-1650

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The recitals and findings contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The City Council hereby approves the City Auditor's Fiscal Year 2025-26 Annual Internal Audit Plan as depicted in the memorandum attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and directs and authorizes the City Auditor to take necessary actions to complete the audit projects described therein.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
