SUBJECT

Consider adoption of an ordinance of the City of Denton authorizing the City Manager to execute a funding agreement between the City and Giving Grace Inc. to provide General Fund Dollars for Street Outreach program furthering the coordinated system of homelessness assistance in Denton, Texas; authorizing the expenditure of funds in an amount not to exceed \$125,450.00; and providing an effective date.

STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT

This action supports Key Focus Area: Foster Economic Opportunity and Affordability.

BACKGROUND

Street Outreach is a vital program in the Housing Crisis Response System continuum of services and in the City's response to unsheltered homelessness. Street Outreach identifies unhoused individuals and families living in places not meant for human habitation and uses trauma-informed care to build rapport and increase access to temporary shelter, permanent housing, and other supportive services.

The City of Denton provides \$703,450 of General Fund dollars annually as part of the City's Program Services Budget, as outlined below, to strengthen the housing crisis response system and reduce homelessness in Denton County.

The FY 2025-2026 Service Agreement with Giving Grace provides \$125,450 of General Fund grant dollars for Street Outreach services for City of Denton residents.
