Receive a report, hold a discussion, and give staff direction on the update regarding Denton's Climate Action Plan goals, measures and dashboard.

STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT

This action supports Key Focus Area: Promote Sustainability and the Environment.

INFORMATION/BACKGROUND

The City of Denton has placed Sustainability as a high priority for City Council and our Community. The Simply Sustainable Framework (SSF) and the Sustainability Framework Advisory Committee (SFAC) inform and provide guidance for making our community more sustainable. The Sustainability Framework Fund created in August 2021 provides funding to supplement actions and implementation of the SSF. On April 19, 2022, the City Council approved Ordinance 22-746 which established Science Based Targets, and the need for a formal Climate Action Plan.

The Climate Action Plan adopted by City Council Resolution No 24-1420 on August 6, 2024, includes three primary goals, 16 actions, and 60 measures. The three goals include both community and municipal actions and measure progress across both areas. The Climate Action Plan focuses on how the city can improve municipal operations and how the City can encourage and incentivize the community to adopt practices that further the City's goals.

The Climate Action Plan Dashboard and scorecard are accessible to the public and track and measure progress toward goals.
