A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DENTON REPEALING POLICY NO. 200.01 "BARRICADING CITY STREETS" DUE TO UPDATED TEXAS AND NATIONAL TRAFFIC CONTROL STANDARDS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
WHEREAS, Policy No. 200.01 "Barricading City Streets" was initially implemented effective July 30, 1984; and
WHEREAS, the City Manager and staff recommend the repeal of Barricading City Streets policy and the City Council desires to repeal such policy
WHEREAS, the implementation of national standards and local ordinances have evolved to include all aspects of the policy. As a result, the policy is no longer specific to the City of Denton, but is now a requirement for all municipalities; NOW, THEREFORE,
THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENTON HEREBY RESOLVES:
SECTION 1. The Policy Statement in "Barricading City Streets", which is incorporated in this section, is hereby repealed as an official policy of the City of Denton:
POLICY STATEMENT: Many maintenance and minor construction operations require full closure or partial closure of city streets. To minimize the risk of injury and property damage to our employees and citizens, proper barricading procedures must be followed.
SECTION 2. This Resolution only repeals the "Policy Statement" portion of Policy No. 200.01 of the City of Denton Policies and Procedures Manual. The "Administrative Procedures" portion of the Policy on Policies, Administrative Directives, and Procedures is an administrative procedure describing the means and methods by which City management implements the Policy Statement. The City Manager is authorized to amend and issue such administrative procedures and directives as deemed necessary to implement the Policy related to personnel and internal operational matters.
SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
